



## Khuloud from Oman receives a new job thanks to WIT

In Oman, Khuloud Ali Al Hatmi recently received a job as a supervisor at the National Craft Training Institute which enables her to support her struggling single father. Khuloud attributes her achievement to the Microsoft Unlimited Potential training she received through Women in Technology.

After completing her final year of high school, Hatmi heard about this program through her friends after explaining to them that she desperately needed a job to support her family. Previously, Khuloud found it difficult to pursue higher education because of her family circumstances. She explains, "I was trying to do similar courses but they were either way too expensive or they didn't suit me because of the longer duration or insufficient curriculum." The two-and-a-half-month program at the Muscat chapter of the Omani Women's Association met Khuloud's needs while creating access to a variety of competitive positions during her job search. Elaborating on why WIT was a perfect match, she says, "Through the WIT training, I learned all the basic and intermediary aspects required to obtain a decent job these days in a very short period."

Khuloud's income has made an immense difference in her family's financial stability. Many of Hatmi's friends and family are encouraged by her success story and are also eager to participate in WIT courses.
