

The National Bank of Oman Supports the Omani Women's Association

The National Bank of Oman (NBO) recently presented a check for 10,000 Omani Rials to Abeer Bent Ali Al-Mukhaini, manager of the Women in Technology (WIT) program in the Omani Women's Association (OWA). The check was presented in a ceremony held at the bank's headquarters to commemorate the event and was well attended by bank officials.

The initiative by the bank's management aims to support services provided by OWA to this important segment of society, especially programs focusing on women. The initiative is considered a contribution from the bank to the association in order to help it overcome the damage caused by recent unfavorable weather conditions, which resulted in the destruction of many program computers.
