



WIT training enhances employability for women in Jordan



"I joined the WIT course in hopes of obtaining a great job, and I did!" declares Khawla Daif Allah Al-Duweiri, a WIT participant from the Taj center in Amman. "Thanks to Microsoft's Unlimited Potential course, I was selected for an interview. Applying the job interview techniques that I learned in the Professional Development course helped me stand out amongst other applicants. I truly believe that I would not have been selected for the job I wanted if I had not finished the WIT program."

The same thoughts are echoed by Mai Al-Hawatma from the Madaba Center: "In my WIT training experience, I particularly enjoyed learning how to effectively communicate with employers. These skills helped me notice the mistakes I used to make in job interviews and improve."

Women who participate in the WIT program in Jordan are excelling in their professional and personal lives. Participants are changing their perspectives about women in the workplace while gaining the skills and confidence needed to successfully secure a job.



Zainab Mas'ood from the Jabal Al Taj Center has completely changed her stance on women in the professional field after joining WIT. She explains, "the funny thing is that I was always against women working. Now I encourage women to engage in the workplace because it allows women to develop their skills and personalities." She continues, "I knew nothing about computers and I have learned so much. I feel much stronger now. During the professional development training, I learned how to solve my problems more efficiently. The way I speak has changed and I feel that people are taking what I say more seriously because I learned how to express my opinion more effectively."
